PEACEPLUS Programme Overview

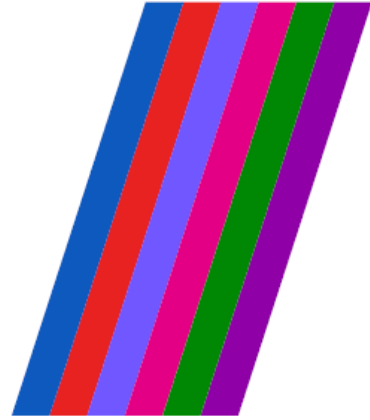


PEACEPLUS (2021-2027)
